AHLP LANDMARK DICTIONARY IS 2011 BOOK OF THE YEAR AWARD FINALIST

Cherry Hill, NJ, April 14, 2012 — *ForeWord Reviews'* list of 2011 Book of the Year Awards finalists includes a title published by Africana Homestead Legacy Publishers (AHLP). *Biographical Dictionary of American Physicians of African Ancestry, 1800-1920* compiled by Geraldine Rhoades Beckford is a finalist in the Reference category. Representing more than 700 publishers, the finalists were selected from 1,200 entries in 60 genre categories. This achievement confirms Beckford's dictionary as an example of independent publishing at its finest. It is also a first time distinction for author and publisher.

Biographical Dictionary of American Physicians of African Ancestry, 1800-1920 presents information on physicians of African ancestry who practiced in the United States or taught those who practiced in the U.S., a unique achievement. It features almost 3,000 entries that provide the physician's birth and death dates, place of practice, medical school and year of graduation, birthplace, parents, spouse, and children. A geographical index and a general index complete the work. The dictionary is available in print in two editions, hardcover, ISBN 978-0-9831151-4-4 and softcover, ISBN 978-0-9831151-5-1. On August 15, 2012, AHLP will release two e-book editions, in PDF (ISBN 978-1-937622-18-3) and EPUB (ISBN 978-1-937622-19-0) formats.

Professor Claudia Lascar of the City University of New York praises the compiler and her work: "*The Biographical Dictionary of American Physicians of African Ancestry, 1800-1920* (Africana Homestead Legacy, 2011) compiled by Geraldine Rhoades Beckford is an extraordinary achievement, due to its scope and depth of coverage. First and foremost it is a 'labor of love' ... More importantly, however, in my opinion is the fact that she has succeeded in raising the public awareness and knowledge of the extraordinary achievements made by American physicians of African ancestry." Before Geraldine Rhoades Beckford officially retired to complete research on early African American physicians, she was an information analyst, as well as a cataloging librarian, in both the public and private sectors. Beckford earned a bachelor of science degree in biology and chemistry at City College of New York, a master in library science at Long Island University, and completed postgraduate studies in history at City University in New York. She is a member of the Organization of American Historians (OAH), the Association of the Study of African American Life and History (ASALH), the Schomburg Society, the Afro-American Historical Association of the Niagara Frontier, and the American Society for Indexing.

ForeWord Reviews' Book of the Year Awards program was established to help publishers shine an additional spotlight on their best titles and bring increased attention to librarians and booksellers of the literary and graphic achievements of independent publishers and their authors. Librarians and
